School Street: City of Whittemore has paid for the cost of the project of resurfacing the road.

Primary election was discussed. Jordan suggested possible way to get more people involved train and be qualified as election inspectors, one suggestion was made to raise the hourly rate. The hourly rate was just raised in the last election cycle two years ago from \$8.50 to \$10.00 per hour.

Clerk did receive a comment from a family that rents the hall that they would like to see handicap access to the pavilion area. Clerk also mentioned that the back deck should be looked at to make sure it's stable, if not it should be replaced.
