Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was recited at 7:00 p.m.

Clerk read Minutes from November meeting, Motion to Accept Minutes made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, GF \$286,616.27, R & B \$19,763.77, motion to approve made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Jay O'Farrell gave the board an update on the county issues.

Bills were read by Clerk, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Committee Report: Blight was again discussed along with sound issues, all planning commission members will review the proposed sample ordinance for blight and give an opinion to the board.

Old Business: Hall improvements were discussed also including possibly needing a new back deck or at least reinforcement, power wash and stain, new screen and better lighting inside, which will need to be dealt with now in the spring as the hall is now closed down for the winter.

Cemetery: Clerk is still in the process of making arrangements to get a quote from Tri Media, which also will not be able to be done until spring. A quote was received from R. Dixon and Son to do additional clean up of the cemetery including removal of the outhouse and numerous brush and bushes in the amount of \$1,000, motion to accept made by Jordan supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Road Commission will be taking care of work needing done on Hottis Road,

Land Division Application that was received from Luke Daniels for a 40 acre split that was approved by the assessor, motion to approve the application made by Jordan supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

BOR oaths given to Dave and Rose Keil. Public comment was received from Mr and Mrs Sain who want to open a small business gun shop on M-65 which is zoned commercial, they were directed to get a zoning permit from the zoning administrator. Other public comment was made regarding the drainage and maintenance issues on School Street, Supervisor will get ahold of the road commission regarding this.
