New Business: Hall improvements were again discussed, including an estimate on fixing and/or update the plumbing.

Wilson Creek Road project estimate is \$13,368.85, with the township's portion being \$9,358.20, motion by Birkenbach to resurface Wilson Creek Road, supported by Jordan, motion carried.
