JUNE 4, 2024

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Stone

Board Members present: Supervisor Chris Stone, Treasurer Sharren Engle, Clerk Stacy McClure, Trustee Matt Jordan and Trustee Paul Birkenbach Absent: None

Clerk read Minutes from May meeting, Motion to accept Minutes made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, general fund balance \$322,355.02, Roads and bridges \$65,267.75 motion to approve made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Bills were read by McClure, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Jay O'Farrell gave state and county updates to the Board, including an additional deputy through a grant, East Tawas not participating in recycling and the jail received a new hot water heater.

Committee Reports: Planning Commission Chair indicated they were still waiting on the decision from the State regarding renewable energy, the solar issue in particular.

Old Business: some residents were concerned about the trash not being picked up.

New Business: Stone obtained a copy of Tawas Township Hall's building/plan for an example in case the Board would be interested in building a new Burleigh Township Hall, which is an option and still being discussed by the board.

Leslie from RES Renewable Energy gave the Board an update as to their solar farm project which is still in its study phase and answered questions from the board and public audience.

Blight Officer Howie Hampft was in attendance and gave the board updates as to the 4 properties he has been working on, Wilson Creek Road has removed 7 or 8 vehicles and property owner on Alabaster has also made some progress with the clean up of that property.
