Bills were read by McClure, motion to pay bills made by Jordan supported by Birkenbach, motion carried. Payment to Iosco County Road Commission will be paid from Roads and Bridges account.

Committee Reports: Planning Commission members Dave and Matt met with Attorney Eppert who is preparing the final draft of the solar ordinance. Matt contact the fence company who is scheduled to begin installation on November 13. Two new blight properties on Plant Road will be referred to Howie for compliance.

Alabaster Road Bridge is closed to being complete.

Township hall closure and winterization will be done the first part of December and will have them look at the leak in the women's bathroom sink pipe.

Clerk reported the township was awarded a \$5,000 grant for new election equipment, supplies and/or materials.
