Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Chris Stone

Board Members present: Supervisor Chris Stone, Treasurer Sharren Engle, Clerk Stacy McClure, Trustee Matt Jordan and Trustee Paul Birkenbach

Board reviewed Minutes from November meeting, Motion to accept Minutes made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, general fund balance \$283,235.66, Roads and bridges \$23,358.57, in addition the dust control refund will be in the amount of \$10,144.18, motion to approve made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Jay O'Farrell updated the board and public on the county issues.

Correspondence: Two Resolutions were presented from Tim Krumm the assessor, Resolution for 2025 March Board of Review and Poverty Exemption 2025 Resolution, motion to approve made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

There has been no progress on the installation of the cemetery fence, but was informed that he should begin on the project Friday, December 6.

The Planning Commission will review the final copy of the solar/wind ordinance at the next meeting and possibly approve to present it to the Board for adoption. NEMCOG is also an option for future reference to prepare new ordinances or amend current ones.

The Board agreed to obligate the remainder of the ARPA funds to either hall improvement or new hall construction costs and general government services.
