Bills were read by McClure, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Board had viewed and toured the old bank building in Whittemore as a potential new site for township hall, public provided their input and concerns, discussion by the board is to also obtain estimates on current hall renovations and inspection and estimate on the cost of a building currently on M-65 in Burleigh Township as a potential site.
