Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Stone

Board Members present: Supervisor Chris Stone, Treasurer Sharren Engle, Clerk Stacy McClure, Trustee Matt Jordan and Trustee Paul Birkenbach Absent: None

Minutes from July meeting were reviewed by the Board, Motion to accept Minutes made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, general fund balance \$287,238.19, Roads and bridges \$59,778.95, motion to approve financial reports made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Committee reports: Planning Commission meeting was held before the regular meeting, NEMCOG rep attended to update on the preparation of the new Master Plan, Planning Commission will be meeting again in October.

Bills were read by McClure, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach supported by Jordan, motion carried.

Old Business: Board received new estimates from GEM Fencing, will make copies and email to board members to finalize at September meeting.

The proposed Consumers Energy Ordinance was reviewed, a motion to approve was made by Jordan and supported by Birkenbach. Clerk will publish the ordinance.

Hall: The majority of feedback from residents regarding the plans for the township hall is to keep our current hall and make improvements. A motion was made to approve up to \$5,000 for hiring an engineer to prepare a improvement/renovation plan, motion was supported by McClure.

New Business: A split authorization was received from Ryan Colvin for property located at 2470 Wilson Creek Road, motion to approve made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach.

Formal request to change property classification at 7207 Prescott Road was received from Mike Provoast (Stoney Acres), motion by Jordan to approve the change, supported by McClure, motion carried. Clerk will send a letter to the Assessor regarding the approval.

Motion to donate all old township tables and chairs to the Chamber and Good News Ministries was made by Jordan and supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.
