

BURLEIGH TOWNSHIP MINUTES

JULY 1, 2025

Meeting called to order at 7:00 p.m.

Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Stone

Board Members present: Supervisor Chris Stone, Treasurer Sharren Engle, Clerk Stacy McClure, Trustee Matt Jordan and Trustee Paul Birkenbach Absent: None

Minutes from June meeting were reviewed by the Board, Motion to accept Minutes made by Jordan, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Financial report was submitted by Engle, general fund balance \$301,786.73, Roads and bridges \$59,778.95, CD balance \$107,313.78, motion to approve financial reports made by Birkenbach, supported by Jordan, motion carried.

There were no committee reports, Planning Commission to hold next meeting in August.

Bills were read by McClure, motion to pay bills made by Birkenbach supported by Jordan, motion carried.

The proposed Consumers Energy Ordinance issue was tabled until the August meeting in order for Rich Castle to be contacted for details and possibly attend the August meeting for clarification.

Howie gave an update on the ongoing current blight properties.

Old Business: Keystone Road. Motion by Jordan to abandon the portion of Keystone Road which contained the sinkhole and refuse ownership and interest in that closed portion, supported by Birkenbach, motion carried.

Hall: Stone informed the Board that he did receive a preliminary quote/estimate on a new foundation for the current township hall in the approximate amount of \$20,000.

New Business: New tables and chairs have been received, board will decide what to do with the old ones at the August meeting.

Clerk received information on a new ADA grant through MAMC available specifically for upgrading accessibility at voting sites up to \$10,000, will require 2 quotes at the time of applying.

Meeting adjourned by motion by Jordan at 8:30 p.m. Next meeting August 5th at the township hall.
